

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Healthy Grilling Recipe: Grilled Corn with Chipotle-Lime Butter

Prep time: 10 minutes **Cook time:** 12 minutes **Makes:** 6 servings

Ingredients

3 tablespoons unsalted butter, softened 1/2 teaspoon grated lime zest 1 teaspoon fresh lime juice 1/2 teaspoon finely minced canned chipotles plus 1/2 teaspoon sauce 1/2 teaspoon salt 6 ears fresh corn in husks Nonstick cooking spray Lime wedges (optional)



Directions

Combine the butter, lime zest and juice, chipotles and sauce, and salt in a small bowl. Set aside.
Heat a grill to medium-high. Remove outer husks from corn, leaving just a few of the innermost layers. Gently pull those down, remove the silks, and pull the husks back up. Lightly mist grill with cooking spray. Cook corn 8 to 12 minutes, turning often, until crisp-tender and lightly charred.
Strip away husks; brush corn with butter mixture. Serve with lime wedges if desired.

Ingredients

4 cups seedless watermelon chunks 1/2 cup sugar Juice of 1 lemon



Directions

Combine all ingredients in a food processor. Puree until smooth. Pour into a shallow, wide pan and freeze for 1 hour. Rake mixture with fork and freeze for another hour. Rake and freeze for one more hour. Rake and serve in cups.

Reclassification-Section 10.4-Contract
