Independence Day Recipe JELL-O Firecrackers

Ingredients

- > 1-1/3 cups boiling water, divided
- > 1 pkg. (3 oz.) JELL-O Berry Blue Flavor Gelatin
- > 1 pkg. (3 oz.) JELL-O Cherry Flavor Gelatin
- > 1 env. KNOX Unflavored Gelatine
- > 1 cup milk, divided
- > 3 Tbsp. sugar
- > 1/2 tsp. vanilla
- > 20 maraschino cherries with stems, well drained, patted dry



Directions

- 1. Add 2/3 cup boiling water to berry gelatin mix in small bowl; stir 2 min. until completely dissolved. Repeat in separate bowl with cherry gelatin mix. Cool.
- Meanwhile, sprinkle unflavored gelatine over 1/4 cup milk in medium bowl; let stand 5 min. Bring remaining milk to simmer in saucepan. Remove from heat; stir in sugar and vanilla. Add to plain gelatine mixture; stir until gelatine is completely dissolved. Cool 10 min.
- 3. Spoon berry gelatin into 20 (1-oz.) plastic shot glasses sprayed lightly with cooking spray, adding about 2 tsp. to each. Refrigerate 15 min. or until set but not firm.
- 4. Top with unflavored gelatine mixture, adding about 2 tsp. to each cup. Refrigerate 10 min.
- 5. Insert cherry, stem end up, into white gelatine layer in each cup. Refrigerate 2 min.
- 6. Cover with cherry gelatin, adding about 2 tsp. to each cup. Refrigerate 2 hours or until firm. Remove desserts from cups before serving.
