<u>PSS Scholarship – Capital Campaign!</u>

It is Capital Campaign Time again for Grand Valley State University! We can use your help with a scholarship close to home! As a PSS staff member do you contribute? If you do have you considered directing your donation to the PSS Scholarship? Did you know we have a PSS Scholarship? We are finding that many people had no idea that we have a scholarship that directly impacts our employee group.

The PSS Scholarship is an endowed scholarship at Grand Valley that is designed to help children or grandchildren of the PSS employee group in the pursuit of an undergraduate degree at GVSU. Since it is endowed Grand Valley matches our donations! Our scholarship has been giving awards since the Fall of 1998! In the last two years alone we have assisted 25 students (direct descendants of the PSS staff!) Last year 14 students were awarded \$600 each.

We are looking to grow our scholarship! Currently our assets are just over \$175,000. Since it is an endowed scholarship we can only draw on a percentage of the interest. How can you help? We are looking to more than our staff to grow this scholarship! Do

you have contacts/vendors that we use frequently? If so we would like to see if they would support our scholarship directly. Please contact Michelle Holstege with the names of any people you feel would potentially consider giving back to our university and more specifically our PSS descendants.

Additional information on the scholarship - To qualify for the scholarship the applicants must meet the following criteria:

- The applicant must be a child or grandchild of an employee in the current Professional Support Staff (PSS) employee group
- This PSS employee may either be currently working and has completed a minimum of three continuous years by the application deadline, or a PSS employee who has retired from GVSU and is currently receiving GVSU retirement benefits
- The applicant must be admitted as a degree seeking student to GVSU and plan to enroll as a full time student for both fall and winter semesters

The deadline for this scholarship is March 1, 2018. The scholarship is awarded based on those criteria annually. The award varies based on the number of students that apply and the amount of funds in the scholarship.
