Anti-Racism White Consciousness Winter 2023 Cohort

Presented by Inclusion and Equity

Systems of oppression and white privilege are often invisible to those that benefit from them. For this reason, it is especially important for those that identify as white to intentionally engage in anti-white supremacy work -- to better identify their own behaviors, to understand the systems at play, and to learn how to deepen personal and institutional anti-racism commitments.

Learning Outcomes (Participants will be able to...)

- Deepen our self-reflective anti-racist practices.
- Understand white identity development.
- Examine how white supremacy culture, white privilege, and intersectionality impact one's relationship to social structures.
- Incorporate daily practice strategies to analyze and dismantle racially oppressive practices and systems.
- Integrate knowledge and practice in our understanding of agency to show up as learners, allies, and accomplices.

This is a 5-session learning cohort with the expectation that participants will be able to attend every session.

Leadership Development Opportunity

Pilot program launching February 2023

In response to feedback from the AP Committee, GVSU affinity groups and the broader community, and in alignment with **Reach Higher 2025**, a group of faculty and staff from our campus community is in the process of developing a university-wide leadership development program. Our goal with the initial pilot is to design a mid-tier leadership development program, while also gaining insight from individuals representing different areas across the university to strengthen the program in the future.

The pilot program will consist of 20-25 individuals participating in 6 interactive, in-person sessions. All regular, full-time employees (AP, PSS, Faculty, MGS, POAM, COAM, Security Staff) are eligible and encouraged to apply. **Your commitment to attending the 6 sessions is required.**

Changes to Multifactor Authentication (Duo)

As GVSU continues the transition to enabling multifactor authentication (Duo) on all major applications, we will be making the following change on January 5, 2023. We will be implementing a change to Microsoft 365 (M365) to reduce the impact of phishing messages on campus. Following this change, you will be prompted by Duo/MFA when logging in to several applications. These applications include Microsoft Teams, Outlook, and Outlook Web Access. You will receive a prompt roughly every 90 days in Outlook and Teams. The prompt from Outlook Web Access will appear more often, but you can reduce it by remembering the machine you are logged into via the web prompt.

A list of exceptions can be found in the following Knowledge Base article (Duo|MFA for M365). Exceptions include traveling and switching machines.
